Iain Russell joins Joint Examination Board

Iain Russell, head of EIP Designs, has been given the opportunity to shape the direction of the CIPA Advanced UK patent exams after being appointed to the Joint Examination Board.

Iain is a UK and European patent attorney and the author of How to Pass P3, the first ever book on the UK patent drafting examination. Iain's expertise covers patents in the electronics and mechanical fields, including telecommunications and computer-implemented inventions. He joined EIP in February 2011.

Iain becomes the second attorney from EIP to sit on the JEB, in addition to Alice Mastrovito, the head of EIP Brands, who has been a member of the examination board since May 2008.
